Any child suffering from any of the following infections will not be permitted to attend the setting until it is clear and no longer infectious, the following are the recommended exclusions periods for infectious diseases:

Illness	Exclusion period
Pandemic Flu	Seven days from onset
Sickness and diarrhea	Until clear and the child no longer feels unwell
Conjunctivitis	until eyes are clear and treatment has been given
Impetigo	Until skin is dry and healing and infection clear
Ear and throat infections	Until child has received treatment and is no longer unwell
Head lice	Until treated
Worms	Until clear
Chicken pox	Until all spots are dry and scabbed over
Scarlet fever	One week after rash appeared
Measles	One week after rash appeared
Rubella	One week after rash appeared
Whooping cough	4-8 week until cough has gone
Mumps	One week after swellings have cleared
Meningitis	Until doctor gives all clear

Parents/carers of children who develop any of the above illnesses must inform the club as soon as possible

Children taken ill whilst at the nursery

If a child is taken ill while at the nursery staff will adhere to the following procedure:

- Contact parent/carer or other emergency contact, relaying child's signs and symptoms but without causing undue alarm or panic and requesting they collect their child from the club
- When possible the child will be given one to one care by a member of staff until their parent/carer arrives
- Isolation will be invoked if the illness is deemed to be infectious or the child is vomiting
