Babies

This term we will be doing 'The Amazing World Around Me', we will be looking at the environment and creating varied range of creative activities such as looking into our different and varied homes, leafy and snowy pictures and learning new songs. We hope that you will continue to partner with us.



Tweenies

This term we will be asking parents to send a snack to nursery that represents their culture to help support and demonstrate the World Testing session. Over the next term Tweenies project is looking 'All Around The World'. We will be focusing on different backgrounds and cultures, tasting different foods and exploring different cultural dress. Parents you can help by telling us about your cultural family events and celebrations.

Please can we ask parents to bring spare dry clothes, indoor shoes and wellies is a spare bag to nursery for their children. Autumn can be an exciting time to explore outside, dancing in the rain, splashing in puddles even den building and best of all mud pies, however their is always a high chance of your child getting wet. During the coming term the children will be doing junk modelling using empty pots, bottles, lids, cartons, tubes, boxes and much more in their room. Pre School



This term we are focusing on Expressive Arts & Design'. We will be learning about textures and colours through a range of materials such as marbling, collage and clay making.

We will be expressing our self through role play, tasting real food and herbs from our very own home corner. We will explore these tastes and smells further by looking at our sensory reactions to certain smells, sounds and tastes that can trigger memories of grandmas house, or how we feel when we smell candy floss at the fun fair or even if we feel like jumping up to sing and dance to a song that has just come on the TV/radio.

You can support your child's current topic by reading a book with them and writing down on a sheet what was your child's favourite part of the book.

All decision are made by management re staffing by 9:30 am if your child is SICK or you are running late you **MUST** call the nursery to inform us!

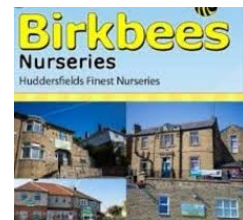
