You will all be pleased to know that Graduation will be taking place this year strictly under covid guidelines. For more information ... WWW. CHILDCARE CHOICES.GOV.UK Babies - As part of their growth and life cycle topic babies have been looking at 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' story sack. They have been tasting the different fruit and vegetables the hungry caterpillar had in the story. Babies have been using their fine motor skills by digging in soil and hunting for bugs and bug printing.

Bumblebees - Planted lettuce and beetroot in the garden as well as talking about how sunflowers and plants grow They have done observational drawings of sunflowers using their fine motor skills. They have talked about the Hungry caterpillar and the life cycle of a butterfly at group time.

Pre-school - They have planted French beans and will watch these grow in nursery. They have been planting flowers in their new planter. Pre-school are able to talk through the life cycle of a butterfly. They have been watching closely at how the chicks have hatched out of the eggs and talking about how they grow. Pre-school leavers have been talking about their feelings and emotions as part of their transition to school, they will be practising to put on uniform using their fine motor skills and recognising the correct order it is worn. They have been getting to know about their new schools and teachers. Pre-school have been practising making simple words.
