For parents information such as fees, EYFS, Learning at home and also download various documents. Throughout nursery we have been promoting 'Active learning' ... by giving children space and time to explore materials by themselves, with their peers and with their practitioners. Children then explore materials using their senses and experiment by mixing things together. Children have been engaging as active learners talking about their experiences and giving us opportunities to join in their conversation and extend their language and interest.

Children learn through having sensory motor experiences and through being active learners ... sensory motor experiences such as feeling, smelling, hearing, looking and listening to objects.

Babies have been exploring with their eyes, hands, feet and mouths they have been experiencing direct tactile contact.

Bluebells and Sunflowers upstairs have been busy as bakers cooks and chefs every week making something savory or sweet what ever tickles their taste buds to take home and enjoy.

As our on going topic we continuously ensure the children know the importance of a good Oral Health therefore there has been lots of brushing teeth going on in nursery.

Also in nursery we have had a 'People who help us' theme where we look at all the services around our area that help us in some way. This could be for example a dentist, nurse, firefighter and many more.

We have used resources such as jigsaw puzzles, books, and transformed our home corners so children could role play as some of these people who help us and discuss their job roles.









### Parent Zone

We are now asking parents to share your child's 'WoW' moments on Parents zone so we are able to see them and we can then print them out and put them into your child's learning journey book. This would mean your child can have a look for themselves and engage with us about what they have been up to at home. It's also helping us work together at home and at nursery and keeping a record of their learning journey.

REMINDER ... Parent zone allows you to log into a secure webpage to see a select quantity of your child's information including:

- Your child's learning journeys
- You can even contribute to your child's learning journey.
- You can see your weekly & monthly bookings
- Account statement showing bills and payments and also daily reports.
